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tags. We are glad to say we release the fish these days. What a prize a mahseer remains though!

The Angling Travel Mahseer Expedition to India in January 2004 was an unqualified success. The fishing was quite fantastic! Numbers of fish caught were astronomic. Several fish of seventy-plus were taken along with a score of forty, fifty and sixty pounders. Long term client and friend, Alan Felstead, achieved the supreme feat of landing eight mahseer over thirty-five pounds in eight consecutive casts.

Two poor monsoons in succession meant that the river was low. We relocated further downstream, taking our guides with us. The fishing proved to be very varied – quite a lot of rapids work from coracles, the round, woven boats, with the assistance of native ghillies. We also fished a deep, mysterious pool. Both fast and slow water produced fish impressive in numbers and in size. Some very big fish were hooked upriver in the quick water but, on spinning gear, there's always the fear that they will come astray, especially in small pools with iceberg-sized rocks. These fish run like freight trains when hooked. Nick Gould lost a cracker, and Abi had at least one rapala smashed beyond recognition. It ended up looking like a coat-hanger! Fish to around fifty-pounds were taken from the rapids; one or two huge fish were sighted and John watched a gold of well over eighty

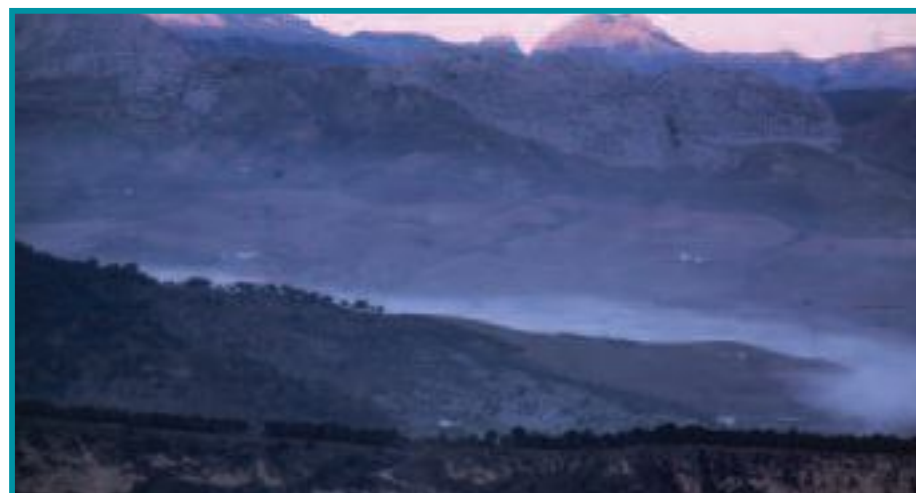

pounds hunting in a shallow pool for twenty minutes or more.

In the huge, deep pool, stunning seventy-pounders were caught by David Lawless and Ian Miller, with Kevin Andrews bagging an absolute cracker of seventy-four pounds. Sometimes the fishing can be slow in the deep pools but if you get a bite you don't want to miss it with fish like this!

Hardy, the great Alnwick tackle company, donated a Gem salmon outfit – rod, reel and four spools with different lines - which worked magnificently. Several decent fish were taken on the fly with a couple of whoppers lost. John feels confident the gear can successfully land bigger fish than that. Fly fishing is a viable option for mahseer. It simply needs the gear, the ambition and confidence to keep at it. The old adage 'you never stop learning' was never truer than this year out in India. Everything has to be adapted and changed to meet new circumstances. With low water, bites in the big pools were less dynamic than in previous years and often took time to develop. Sometimes, it seemed small fish were pecking at the bait before it would



suddenly go - with dramatic consequences! We found fishing without lead produced a positive response. And leaving a fair amount of slack line between rod tip and bait also helped build up the fishes' confidence. Perhaps sometime the whole concept of the ragi ball might well have to be reconsidered. Mahseer are massive carp/barbel and we all know how quickly they learn in any country.

As always, the spirit in the group was magnificent and standards were kept high around the dinner table largely because of Amanda - was it three fish over thirty pounds she managed!? It's easy for spirits to be high when everyone in the group catches fish over twenty pounds, and when everything supports the perfect fishing experience!

Everything about India is magnificent: the weather, this river valley is beautiful, so peaceful and teems with diverse exotic wildlife, brilliant ghillies, friendly, diligent camp staff, the pace of life, starlit evening drinks by the campfire, early morning tea on your balcony, ...and the constant knowledge that at any second your life can be completely transformed. One bite and your fishing world is blown apart. One battle and you might never be the same fisherman again.

And that's how we intend to keep it in 2005. We have a splendid programme. We are going to keep things as flexible as possible and, in short, follow the water and the fish. If the water's high, for example, we've established that we can move to the very top camp. There's some amazing scenery up there with fish hardly

ever pursued. There are big fish, too, possibly even the biggest on the river when the conditions are right.

If the river is lower than we would want, then we'll move to one of the other two camps downriver. We can even fish both and swop around the midway point in the journey. We can set up a simple satellite camp up river for a night to fish water that has been rarely seen for a half century if wished. The guides are becoming ever more aware of the sort of fishing Angling Travel clients need... some sitting over the rods for the odd monster fish but also the water to spin and fly fish.

There's no more testing challenge in world freshwater fishing than the mahseer. They are bludgeoningly violent fish. The fight from a big mahseer is something that you will never, ever forget. You will not find better mahseer fishing or ghillies anywhere.

If you can, do India with John, a mahseer expert (his documentary about them called Casting For Gold, is still shown worldwide) He is great fun and transfers his passion, inspiration and knowledge



very quickly. He supports you as much or as little as you choose. We always get a superb group of people too. If you wish to travel alone or with friends on dates to suit you, from November 2004 to March 2005, you would also of course be very well looked after by the ghillies and camp manager –they know what our clients deserve.

We urge you to book for the next trip very quickly, interest is very strong and priority must go to our regular customers, several of whom book instantly their plane lands back at Heathrow. Remember, the fishing just seems to get better and better as our experience of it grows and our bond with the guides strengthens.

Over the past year, John has been re-examining his Norfolk roots in a way that he would not have thought possible a decade ago. He has found a maze of pools, lakes, streams, rivers and some of the most unexpected fishing, he feels, in the U.K. What's the appeal? Going back to the

haunts of his childhood, seeing how waters have changed and developed, meeting old friends, reliving old memories. The fishing has proved spectacular. John treats it with huge respect and fishes these places incredibly lightly. Even so, within a year, his secret venues have turned up both pike and carp to over thirty pounds, barbel to more than fifteen along with big tench, roach, chub and even mullet and sea bass. Want to join him one weekend this in July, September or November?

You'll stay in any one of the enchanting, characterful little hotels or inns. John meets you at breakfast time – or if we're tench fishing – at dawn, each day. A plan is made. Your own input and agenda is vital and in addition John will suggest places that he knows are very much on the boil. You might start at one of his little marshland pools fishing for carp near forty pounds, barely ever fished for. Or one of his hidden pike lakes, deep in Norfolk estates, a lost, lonely land, where thirties and fish of forty pounds, are on the cards and upper doubles and twenties proliferate, a haven for ornithologists and pike men too! Fish for pike that have rarely, if ever, been touched. You might drift further south and take a boat out up the River Wensum for big roach. You might happen upon one of the mill pools John has access to and land a very big barbel. If time, tide and weather are all favourable then you might walk the lonely, north coastline with a light rod, spinner and a pair of binoculars, searching the prolific shoals of bass. An eight or nine pounder is spectacular – but at four and five pounds average they fight like little tigers on light gear. And if the weather suits, they're catchable on a fly.

These are expeditions that demand flexibility: you might have your bait next to a thirty-five pound mirror carp in a crystal clear lake one second or a four pound mullet the next. Perhaps you'll do some float fishing, perhaps some Czech nymphing for a shoal of enormous dace.



What is certain is that you will enjoy absorbing, unexpected sport on some of the most stunningly beautiful, unanticipated waters you're ever likely to come across. You'll adore the insight John gives you and the excitement of wondering what will be coming next.

Greenland is a land of snow and ice and rivers as pure as anywhere you will find in the world. It is the hugely prolific centre of the world's Arctic char populations. The west coast rivers that we fish heave with these extraordinarily beautiful, fascinating creatures that run them in their hundreds of thousands. What fish they are! Explosively coloured, shining silver to throbbing, vivid reds, fish of between four and seven pounds. It's fly fishing beyond compare. It takes your breath away. John has made many trips to Greenland since the early 1990s and sampled a whole clutch of rivers. We're concentrating now on the best of the bunch. This is the most basic camping of all the trips we offer. Still, you'll have everything you need.

You will experience at least two or three rivers during your stay. Constant variety

and exploration, new water, with new challenges and new fish; chances are you'll fish a pool that's never before seen fly or spinner. four and eight pounds perhaps. Here they're running in hundreds and thousands! Every river is crystal clear water so stalk individual fish. A gleam, the instinct to strike and a fish hell-bent on escape. The char does not give you an easy fight Many pools can hold five hundred or even a thousand fish!! A hundred fish in one day is common. These are the bonefish of freshwater. You can

fish with a number six weight, a six pound leader and hook fish after fish and see your backing appear time after time. Imagine your heart thump as a seven pound char rips you away to the sea.

obligatory but it’s thrilling. Recent trips have proved that fly fishing for the barbel is quite exceptional, as effective as bait fishing. And the dry fly has proved just as effective as the nymph. Don’t worry if you’re not a fly fishing buff: big casts are not necessary. It’s close-in, intimate stuff on gorgeous, meandering rivers. We have two or three venues, Average weights are probably between two and six pounds but on fly gear these go like trains. Of course, you can bait fish as well...dapping a natural grasshopper is sensational! Whilst the fish aren’t massive, a five-pound barbel on a six or seven-weight fly rod will give you a fight that you’ll never forget.

The bass fishing opportunities are historic. John has linked up with a group of likeminded individuals who control the best bass fishing lake in southern Spain. 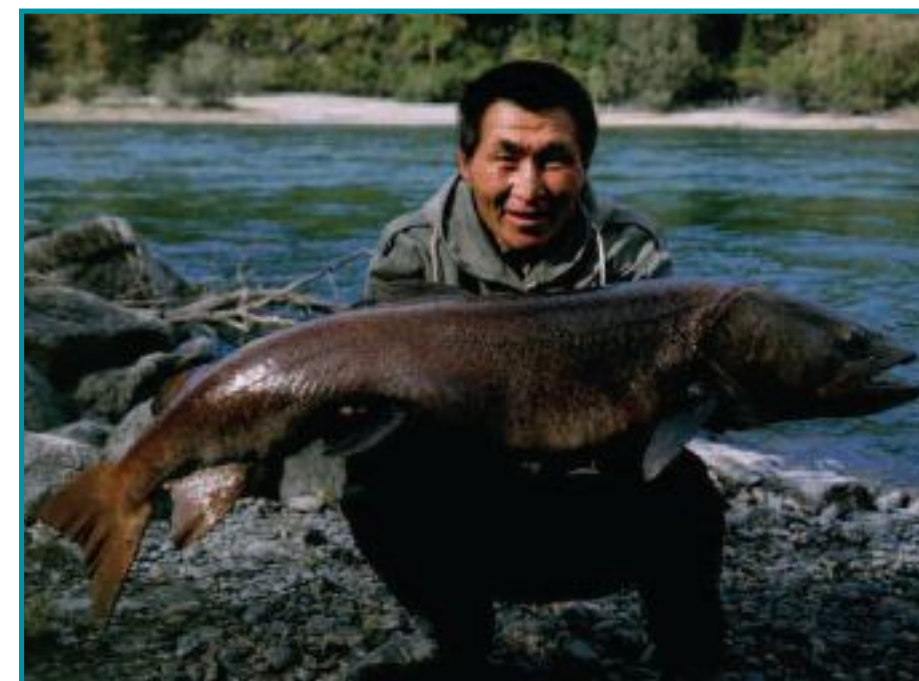

TERMS & CONDITIONS

1 Your contract is with Angling Travel Limited, trading as Angling Travel. All bookings are made and accepted subject to the terms set out in these conditions.

2 Booking

A contract shall exist in respect of a holiday on completion of the booking form and our acceptance of it and return of the booking confirmation.

3 Price

3.1 The price for the holiday is that specified in the brochure.
3.2 Included in the price are the accommodation, transport and services specified in the brochure.
3.3 Not included in the price, unless specified, are travel to the holiday location, alcoholic drinks and other items of a personal nature.

4 Payment

4.1 The deposit specified on the booking form is payable on making the booking. The balance of the price must be paid 8 weeks before the commencement date of the holiday. Some trips require the full balance to be paid earlier - you will be informed of this at the time your place is reserved. No holiday documentation will be released unless payment has been received in full.
4.2 For your security all monies received from customers are held in a trust account.
4.3 The person in whose name the booking is made acts on behalf of all other persons named and becomes responsible to us for all payments in respect of this booking. Your reservation will be confirmed upon receipt of the booking. A copy of your valid insurance policy for travel must be received with your final payment.

5 Revision of price
